

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out how Cuba Private Travel uses and protects any information that you give to www.cubaprivatetravel.com when you use this website.

Should you provide any information by which you can be identified when using this website, you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

What we collect

We will only store information that you choose to enter into this website manually and have taken all steps possible to minimise data gathering on our site. The information that you choose to supply can include:

- name , contact information including email, telephone number and postal address

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

What we do with the information we gather

- We may periodically send emails about new events and articles that we think you may find interesting using the email address you have provided.
- From time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone or mail.

Cookies

www.cubapivatetravel.com will only use essential cookies required in the supply of our website and only for the duration of your session on our website. You can learn more about session cookies at www.allaboutcookies.org/cookies/session-cookies-used-for.html

If you elect to view www.cubapivatetravel.com in a language other than the default language, we make use of an anonymous cookie to ensure that you can continue to view the website in your preferred language, even if you return to the site in a future session. This is for your convenience and you can delete this cookie at any time using your browser settings.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the Cuba Private Travel website.

If you don't want to receive cookies, you can modify your browser so that it notifies you when cookies are sent to it or you can refuse cookies altogether. You can also delete cookies that have already been set.

If you wish to restrict or block web browser cookies that are set on your device then you can do this through your browser settings; the Help function within your browser should tell you how. From time to time we may use google analytics to understand how the Cuba Private Travel site is being used in order to improve the user experience. All user data studied will be anonymous. Other information

Social buttons: On many of the pages of the Cuba Private Travel site you will see 'social buttons'. These enable users to share or bookmark the web pages. In order to implement these buttons, and connect them to the relevant social networks and external sites, they use scripts from domains outside Cuba Private Travel.
