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Head to Gibara for the Festival Internacional de Cine Pobre (International Low Budget Film Festival) accompanied by a guide, to get the most out of the festivities.



**Diving in Tanques Azules**

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Horse ride to get to these natural pools. Accompanied by your guide, you will dive around the entrance to Cuba's largest flooded cavern, Tanques Azules. With 3600 m so far explored, this cavern has stalactites and stalagmites originally formed before the cave was flooded by rising sea levels. It is one of the most beautiful in the region with unique wildlife such as shrimps and the blind fish.



**Cave Exploration on foot in Gibara**

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Explore the Cueva del Agua. This 1.5 km long cave has spectacular formations and is known for its banana crops amid limestone. The trail includes a 30 min walk to get to the entrance and a 1 hour walk inside of the labyrinthine cave.



**Walking tour of Gibara**

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Be guided through the beautiful city seeing the excellent architectural designs of colonial buildings, and the well-planned layout of the city's streets, houses and parks. You will visit Los Caneyes view point south of the town.
