The island is not known for its services or food, but for its amazing turquoise-tinted beaches. For dinner, you will have a reservation at El Cuajani, a cozy restaurant that serves fresh and inventive dishes. You can expect to be impressed by their friendly service and their original take on Cuban cuisine.

HAVANA – COLONIAL CHARM & PRIVATE TASTINGS

Return to Havana and check into one of the city's elegant boutique hotels or design casas — options include La Reserva Vedado, El Encanto, or boutique suites at Kempinski for a luxe twist. Explore Old Havana with a historian guide, discovering hidden courtyards and stunning architecture. Enjoy a private cigar and rum tasting at a historic mansion, followed by a fun salsa class — cocktail in hand! Dinner tonight is a feast at Los Mercaderes, a beautifully restored colonial mansion, live music and mojitos for sure

HEMINGWAY'S CUBA & FAREWELL DINNER

Hop into a 1950s convertible classic car for a journey through Hemingway's Havana — visit his home Finca Vigía, see his boat Pilar, and explore Cojímar, the fishing village that inspired *The Old Man and the Sea*. Stop for a delicious Cuban lunch at Ajiaco Café. Enjoy a final free afternoon for last-minute shopping or sight seeing. End your Cuban adventure in style with dinner at La Guarida, Havana's most iconic private restaurant, famous for its film-star guests and atmospheric setting.
